Subject: Amendment of COA (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 1983-reg.


Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter no. CA/1/2016/Regulations dated the 15th Oct, 2016 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the Council's proposal for amendment of regulations 4(1) of the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 1983 relating to admission to the architecture course has been considered by this Ministry. This Ministry have no objection to the amendment of regulation 4(1) of the said Regulations by replacing Mathematics and English as subjects of examination for admission to five year B. Arch. Course with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also 50% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level of examination. Accordingly, necessary action may be taken to replace the existing regulations 4(1) and 4(2) of the said Regulation by the following proposed clause:-

"No candidate shall be admitted to the architecture course unless she / he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination".
